<u>Homophone Examples</u>	
way Which <u>way</u> did she go?	weigh How much does it <u>weigh</u> ?
whole He ate the <u>whole</u> sandwich.	hole The dog dug a <u>hole</u> .
berry That <u>berry</u> looks ripe.	bury I'm going to <u>bury</u> this treasure.
